## A RESOLUTION OF THE HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE BUDGET FOR THE HENRY COUNTY GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL 2018-2019

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Henry County,
Tennessee at its July Recessed Session, 2018, adopted the budget for the Henry
County General Fund for fiscal 2018-2019; and,

WHEREAS, the said Board of County Commissioners of Henry County,
Tennessee must authorize and approve any and all changes and amendments of
the said budget of the Henry County General Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the expenditures authorized in the said budget of the Henry County General Fund will be insufficient in certain line items with funds being available for transfer; and,
