#### **RESOLUTION NO. 3-1-17**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO AFFIRM COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL TITLE VI REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, both Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 provide that no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Attorney General opined in Opinion No. 92.47 that state and local governments are required to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act in administering federally funded programs; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Division of the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development administers the Three-Star Program and awards financial incentives for communities designated as Three-Star communities; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development receiving federal financial assistance, all communities designated as Three-Star communities must confirm that the community is in compliance with the regulations of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the county legislative body of Henry County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session on this 17<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2017, at Henry County Court House in Paris, Tennessee, that:

**SECTION 1.** The legislative body of Henry County, Tennessee declares that the county is in compliance with the federal Title VI regulations.

**SECTION 2.** The Department of Economic and Community Development may from time to time monitor the county's compliance with federal Title VI regulations.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption, the public welfare requiring it.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 4-1-17**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF CERTAIN DELINQUENT TAX PROPERTY AT A REDUCED PRICE

**WHEREAS**, Henry County acquires ownership of parcels which were the subject of the annual delinquent tax collection suits; and

WHEREAS, these parcels are acquired when no other bidder bids on a parcel at the Delinquent Tax Sale; and

WHEREAS, while Tennessee law requires that no parcel of land purchased by the County at a delinquent tax sale shall be resold for an amount less than the total amount of the taxes, penalty, cost and interest accrued against such parcel, unless he legislative body, upon application, determines that it is impossible to sell the parcel of land for such amount, and grants permission to offer the land for sale at some amount to be fixed by such legislative body; and

WHEREAS, it appears that delinquent tax property assessed on the maps of the Assessor of Property as Map 105F, Group B, Control Map 105F, Parcel 016.00, S/I 000 is impossible to sell for the entire amount of the delinquent tax debt.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Henry County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2017, a majority or more of the membership concurring that:

- 2. Map 105F, Group B, Control Map 105F, Parcel 016.00, S/I 000 cannot be sold for the accumulated total of taxes, interest, penalties and costs against it; therefore, pursuant to *Tenn. Code Ann. §67-5-2507*, permission is granted to offer a quitclaim deed of said parcel to **Raymond Williams** (or higher offeror) in consideration for amount of \$1,500 (or higher offer), subject to the requirements of advertising and the opportunity for any other interested party to raise to the offer as prescribed by law.
- 3. The County Mayor and County Trustee are authorized to execute quitclaim deeds quitclaiming the above-referenced parcels to the highest offeror.

#### **RESOLUTION 5-1-17**

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE
TENNESSEE GENERAL ASSEMBLY NAME
THE PLANNED TENNESSEE BUREAU OF
INVESTIGATION FACILITY IN MADISON
COUNTY AFTER THE LATE TBI AGENT
DE'GREAUN "DEE" FRAZIER IN
COMMEMORATION OF HIS DEATH INTHE
LINE OF SERVICE

WHEREAS, Dee Frazier is the first and only Tennessee Bureau of Investigation (TBI) agent ever killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Dee Frazier was serving honorably when killed during an undercover sting operation on August 9th, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Dee Frazier's death occurred in Madison County where a new TBI facility is planned; and

WHEREAS, the new TBI facility is intended to serve the West Tennessee area where Dee Frazier was a longtime resident, and where he served as a law enforcement officer in various capacities including as a University of Memphis Police Officer, a Miiiington Police Officer, a Shelby County Sheriffs reserve officer, and a TBI agent; and

WHEREAS, TBI Director, Mark Gwyn described Dee Frazier as "... exactly what we look for in a TBI agent: hardworking, enthusiastic and dedicated to making Tennessee a better place to live"; and

WHEREAS, Dee Frazier's sacrifice Is significant in that he was only 35 years of age at the time of his death and leaves behind a wife and two young children; and

WHEREAS, the \$25,000,000.00, 40,000-square-foot TBI facility is already planned and the commemorative naming of the facility for Dee Frazier would add no additional costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Henry County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session on this day, the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2017, that:

- 1. The Board of County Commissioners of Henry County, Tennessee does hereby request that the Tennessee General Assembly name the new West Tennessee TBI facility be named after the late TBI Agent De'Greaun Frazier; and
- 2. A copy of this Resolution be sent by the County Mayor requesting that such be taken by the Tennessee General Assembly; and that copies of this Resolution be sent to our Tennessee State Senator and Tennessee State Representatives representing Henry County, Tennessee.
