A RESOLUTION OF THE HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO APPOINT CERTAIN CITIZENS AND COMMISSIONERS TO VARIOUS BOARDS, COMMITTEES, AND POSITIONS

RESOLUTION NO. 2-12-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO AUTHORIZE CERTAIN CHANGES IN THE BUDGET FOR THE HENRY COUNTY GENERAL FUND FOR FISCAL 2018-2019

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Henry County, Tennessee at its July Recessed Session, 2018, adopted the budget for the Henry County General Fund for fiscal 2018-2019; and,

WHEREAS, the said Board of County Commissioners of Henry County,
Tennessee must authorize and approve any and all changes and amendments of the
said budget of the Henry County General Fund; and,

WHEREAS, the expenditures authorized in the said budget of the Henry County General Fund will be insufficient in certain line items with funds being available for transfer; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary and appropriate that the said budget of the Henry County General Fund be amended to provide additional funds for certain line items.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Henry County, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this the 17th day of December 2018, a majority or more of said membership concurring, that the budget for the Henry County General Fund be and hereby is amended as follows, to-wit:

INCREASE ACCOUNT 55190-316-HIST, entitled, "Contribution Henry County Historical Society," in the amount of \$5,000.00

DECREASE ACCOUNT 39000, entitled "Unappropriated Fund

Balance," in the amount of \$5,000.00

This transfer is to transport and restore a 1927 La France Fire Engine originally owned by the City of Paris.

RESOLUTION NO. 3-12-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO APPROVE THE ADOPTION OF THE 2018 HENRY COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

WHEREAS, the County Mayor's Office of Emergency Management has completed an update of the 2018 Henry County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, and it was submitted to the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency for consideration and approval; and

WHEREAS, the County of Henry has participated in the 2018 plan update process, and is committed to the Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan concept by adoption of the previous 2012 plan, *Resolution 2-12-12 on December 17*, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the Tennessee Emergency Management Agency has given tentative approval of the updated 2018 Henry County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan as of November 6, 2018 and it shall be distributed to jurisdictions, agencies and county municipalities for local adoption completion, and Federal emergency funding and grants are conditioned upon adoption of updated plan; and

WHEREAS, upon submittal of adoption documentation by participating jurisdictions, the Federal Emergency Management Agency will issue final

formal approval of the 2018 Henry County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan to the County of Henry.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Henry, Tennessee assembled in regular session on this 17th day of December, 2018 that:

SECTION 1: The County of Henry hereby will recognize this plan as the principal Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation plan for the County of Henry, and it shall be mandatory for the County of Henry, its municipalities, and political subdivisions in accordance with the Tennessee Code Annotated and the Civil Defense Act of 1950 as amended, to adopt the updated Hazard Mitigation plan upon.

RESOLUTION NO. 4-12-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO ADOPT THE LOCAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS PLAN UPDATE AND TO ADOPT THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the County Mayor's Office of Emergency Management has completed an update of the Henry County Basic Emergency Operations Plan as of November 1, 2018, and shall be distributed to response agencies and county municipalities for local adoption; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has developed the National Incident Management System, and all Federal emergency funding and grants are conditioned upon adoption of such system; and

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee has adopted the National Incident Management System and has directed all political subdivisions of the state to adopt the National Incident Management System; and

WHEREAS, the various emergency response agencies managing emergency incidents in Henry County have committed to use the National Incident management System,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Henry County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session on this 17th day of December, 2018, a majority or more of the membership concurring that:

SECTION 1: The County of Henry hereby adopts the updated 2018 Henry County Basic Emergency Operations Plan as the principal emergency management plan for Henry County, and shall be mandatory for Henry County, its municipalities, and political subdivisions in accordance with the Tennessee Code Annotated §7-601 and the Civil Defense Act of 1950 as amended.

SECTION 2: The County of Henry hereby reaffirms the use and adoption of the National Incident Management System established by the United States Department of Homeland Security for the management of all emergency incidents by all emergency response departments and agencies of the County of Henry and its municipalities.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effective from and upon its passage approval.

RESOLUTION NO. 5-12-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE HENRY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF CERTAIN DELINQUENT TAX PROPERTY AT A REDUCED PRICE

WHEREAS, Henry County acquires ownership of parcels which were the subject of the annual delinquent tax collection suits; and

WHEREAS, these parcels are acquired when no other bidder bids on a parcel at the Delinquent Tax Sale; and

WHEREAS, while Tennessee law requires that no parcel of land purchased by the County at a delinquent tax sale shall be resold for an amount less than the total amount of the taxes, penalty, cost and interest accrued against such parcel, unless the legislative body, upon application, determines that it is impossible to sell the parcel of land for such amount, and grants permission to offer the land for sale at some amount to be fixed by such legislative body; and

WHEREAS, it appears that delinquent tax property assessed on the maps of the Assessor of Property as Map 095O, Group K, Control Map 095O, Parcel 004.00 is impossible to sell for the entire amount of the delinquent tax debt; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Henry County, Tennessee, assembled in regular session on this the 17th day of December, 2018, a majority or more of the membership concurring that:

- 1. Map 095O, Group K, Control Map 095O, Parcel 004.00, cannot be sold for the accumulated total of taxes, interest, penalties and costs against it; therefore, pursuant to *Tenn. Code Ann. §67-5-2507*, permission is granted to offer a quitclaim deed of said parcel to **Cynthia Gornick** (or higher offeror) in consideration for amount of \$1,250.00 (or higher offer), subject to the requirements of advertising and the opportunity for any other interested party to raise to the offer as prescribed by law.
- 2. The County Mayor and County Trustee are authorized to execute quitclaim deed quitclaiming the above-referenced parcel to the highest offeror.
